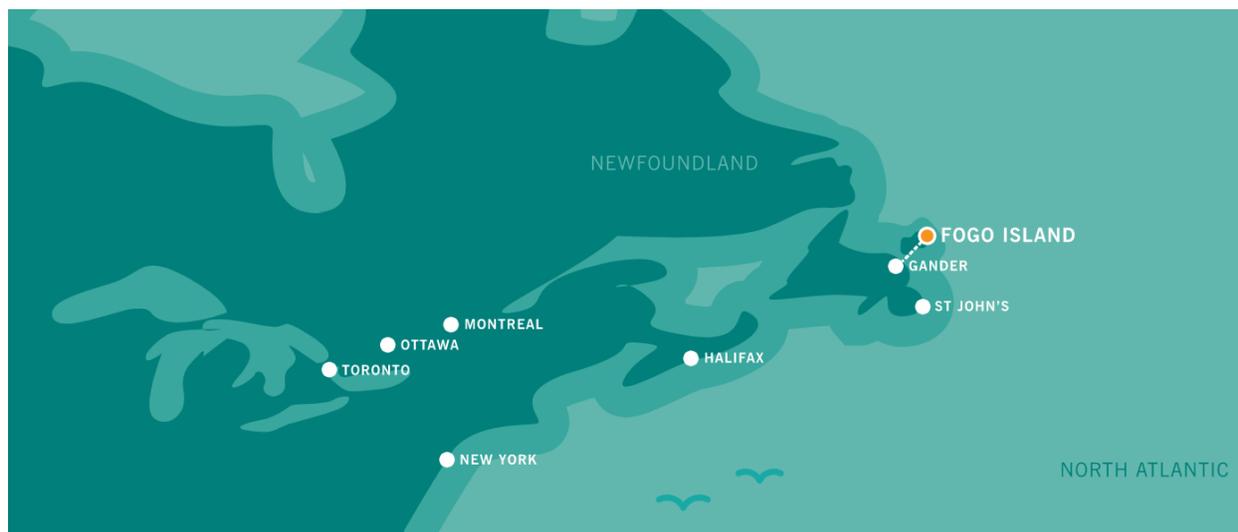


How to get to Fogo Island and back



Here are the options:

By commercial air:

Air Canada operates a direct flight between Toronto-Gander-Toronto during the spring and summer. As with many things these days, it could be canceled. So *caveat emptor*. But it's the easiest way to get to Fogo and back.

Air Canada also flies to Gander via Halifax and St. John's.

**Please note: If you want to take the Inn's private charter bus from Gander Airport to catch the 11:30 a.m. ferry to Fogo on May 25, you'll need to get into Gander the night before. The best place to stay overnight is The Comfort Inn on the Trans Canada Highway, and a 10-minute drive to the airport: [+1 709-256-3535](tel:+17092563535).

Helicopter:

If you prefer to take a helicopter directly from Gander to Fogo Island, avoiding the drive to Farewell on the north coast and Fogo, as well as the ferry ride, please speak to the Inn's reservations team directly 1-855-268-9277 or reservations @fogoislandinn.ca.

Make your own travel arrangements to get to Gander, Newfoundland (YQX). From there, the helicopter will take you to the airstrip on Fogo Island in less than 30 minutes. A local host will meet you at the Airstrip and drive you the 15 minutes back to the Inn.

Car rental

You may want to rent a car in Gander and drive to Farewell, onto the Fogo ferry, and then on to the Inn - and back to Gander. Up to you. Makes sense especially if you're going elsewhere in Newfoundland and making a road trip of it. As rental cars are scarce, please be sure to book well in advance.

Insurance

This is very important for two reasons: COVID's refusal to leave, and the capricious weather which could shut down the ferry and leave you stranded, or make it impossible for you to get to the Inn - although in late May, this is not the risk it is in March or October.

That said, we strongly urge you to get or extend your travel insurance -for medical coverage, for trip cancellation and trip interruption (for any reason), and coverage for COVID and acts of God.
